The aim for this area is to have a consistent mathematics plan and assessment regime, like the John Paul II approach to literacy. The Insight project is a major component of CET's goal to be the most improved education system in Australia. 2.1 Create a parent engagement strategy as per Validation recommendations.	Create a parent engagement plan to support regular parental participation in the school, as to reflect best practice in the area	2025-2026
3.2 Write a new response to the Archbishop's Charter, as per Validation recommendations.	As per CET requirements, write an updated response to the Archbishop's Charter. This will be presented to the Board and then submitted to CET for approval. Once approved, this will be presented to the school during Catholic Education Week in 2024.	By the end of Term 3, 2024
3.3 Create a John Paul II Sustainability Plan, strengthening the Little Dove Café and creating a school garden plan.	With the introduction of a sustainability teacher and a school garden, this project will aim to cement strong links with the Little Dove café and broader curriculum connections.	2024-2025
3.4 Create and implement a Library operations plan.	The new John Paul II Library is in the very heart of the school. A Library operations document will allow effective use of the space, maximising student participation and outcomes.	By the end of Term 2, 2024
